


How does it works?




Who said that art was boring? What if street art had much to say about old masterpieces?

DADA can be launched abroad as a magazine, with a publication rate chosen by you.


That's the best way to retain the readership: you sell the magazines both in bookstores and by subscription, as we do in France or in the Netherlands.
